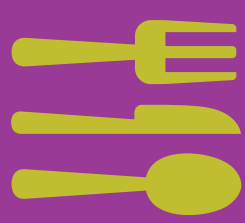

The **Educational Attainment** task force group is addressing the social determinants of health with objectives changing educational attainment in Tulsa County.

In 2016, members of the task force reported knowledge of 27 sites offering out-of-school time programs and now there is knowledge of 41 sites which is a 52% increase.



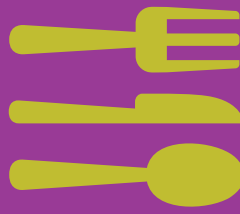
The **Health Care** task force group is addressing the social determinants of health with objectives to improve health care in Tulsa County.

10 newly trained Tulsa City County Library health information ambassadors fulfilled more than 5,372 health information assistance requests. Health is any assistance they provided relating to health conditions, treatments, illness prevention, medications, access to healthcare or social services, medical insurance issues, and diet or exercise as it relates to health.



The **Built Environment** task force group is addressing the social determinants of health with objectives changing the built environment in Tulsa County.

64% of Tulsa County will now have active transportation options through the GO Plan adopted by the City of Tulsa as it's first on-street bike/ped plan. The City of Tulsa makes up about 64% of Tulsa County. The GO Plan connects every socio-economic area of the City of Tulsa with an appealing option for physical activity.



The **Food Environment** task force group is addressing the social determinants of health with objectives to improve the food environment in Tulsa County.

28% of ZIP codes in Tulsa County have free cooking demonstrations. 12 out of 43 ZIP codes were identified as offering cooking demonstrations.
